# New England Bowlers Association Cambridge Credit Counseling Invitational Tournament 

## General

- This tournament shall be governed by the New England Bowlers Association and will be sanctioned with the United States Bowling Congress
- This tournament shall not count towards any Bowler of the Year Point categories
- Entry Fee for this tournament shall be $\$ 150$, which will be broken up into the following categories: Lineage, Prize Fund, Expenses, Side Pots
- \$1 from every entry throughout the previous calendar year shall go towards the prize fund of this tournament
- Cashing minimums shall follow the standard singles tournament rules


## Lane Conditions / Oil Schedule

- This tournament shall be contested on a pattern whose overall ratio shall not exceed 5:1
- The lane condition shall be determined in collaboration between the Tournament Director, the host bowling center, and anyone else the Board of Directors deem appropriate
- A fresh lane condition shall be used at the beginning of the following rounds: Qualifying, Cashers', and Finals


## Qualifying

- All participants shall bowl five (5) games of qualifying across ten (10) lanes
- After each game, bowlers on the left lane will move left, and bowlers on the right lane will move right
- One in four (4) participants will qualify for the Cashers' Round
- All side cuts (i.e. Senior, Women) from the standard single's tournament shall be combined and one in six (6) will qualify for the Cashers' Round
- Side cut advancers are guaranteed
- If any/all side cut advancers do not make the regular cut, they will be taken in addition to participants who make it through the regular cut
- Any ties shall be broken by the standard single's tournament format for making a squad cut


## Cashers' Round

- All participants from qualifying, and the top 16 in points from the previous season, shall bowl five (5) games across ten (10) lanes
- After each game, bowlers on the left lane will move left, and bowlers on the right lane will move right
- If there are any ties for 16 th place in points from the previous season, all participants tied shall qualify for the Cashers' Round
- If anyone from the top 16 does not bowl, their guaranteed spot into the Cashers' Round is forfeited
- The top 24 participants will advance to the Finals of the tournament
- All participants in the Cashers' Round shall cash
- Side cuts shall follow the same format as qualifying with the following exceptions:
- A side spot is not guaranteed, as there must be six (6) entrants to guarantee a spot into the finals
- If a side spot is guaranteed, and any/all finish outside the regular cut, those spots will be taken from the regular cut spots to meet the 24 participant requirement


## Finals

## Round of 24

- Advancing bowlers shall bowl two (2) additional games.
- After each game, bowlers on the left lane will skip three (3) pair to the left, and bowl on the fourth, and bowlers on the right lane will skip three (3) pairs to the right, and bowl on the fourth.
- The top 16 bowlers, based on their two (2) game total pinfall, will advance to Match Play.
- Any ties for 16th place will follow the standard singles tournament format for making a squad cut.


## Match Play

- The top 16 bowlers will be seeded based on their seven (7) game total pinfall.
- Any ties in the seven game pinfall will be broken by the standard singles tournament rule for ties with the same qualifying score.
- Match Play will follow the standard singles tournament format with the following exception:
- If the lower seed wins the match, an additional game will be bowled.
- The winner of the second game match will advance to the next round of the bracket.


## Side Pots

## High Game Pot

- A predetermined amount of the entry fee shall be allocated towards high game pots (\$10)
- The high game pot will run in both the Qualifying and the Cashers' Round
- One of each participant of the Qualifying Round that would advance to the Cashers' Round's side pot fee shall be applied to the Cashers' Round fund
- One in four participants advance to the Cashers' Round. 75\% of the funds collected in Qualifying shall be used for the Qualifying Round High Game Pot, and $25 \%$ (along with $100 \%$ of the top 16 's funds) shall be used in the Cashers' Round
- The number of High Game Pot pay positions per game shall be determined by the Tournament Director


## Brackets

- A predetermined amount of the entry fee shall be allocated towards brackets (\$15)
- Brackets will be run in both the Qualifying and Cashers' Round
- Everyone will be entered into five (5) $\$ 3$ brackets during Qualifying
- Bowlers may enter into an additional 20 brackets in each round
- During the Cashers' Round, only the top 16 will be automatically entered into brackets
- Top 16 will be entered into the same number as everyone in Qualifying
- Qualifiers from the Qualifying round can enter brackets
- Bracket funds will be returned $100 \%$
